

Expected Learning Outcomes

Spanish Stage 4: Intermediate IIIH, Advanced IH Spanish Intermediate II Culture and Communication (does not complete stage 4) Courses 385, 387, 389

By the end of stage 4, students will have expanded the ability to perform all the tasks developed in stage 3. Having developed the ability to use sentences, and paragraph-length and essay-length messages with some patterns of errors that do not interfere with meaning, the student:
