SUBJECT: Seating of the Concord School Committee and Election of Officers

Annually at the first School Committee meeting following the conclusion of Town Meeting, the first order of business is to seat the new School Committee, to elect its officers and make other necessary appointments.

In light of the fact that the Carlisle election date is May 10, 2010, the seating of the regional committee will not take place until the May 25, 2010 joint meeting. The seating of the Concord School Committee and election of chair and vice-chair will take place this evening.

At the joint meeting on May 25, 2010, the Concord-Carlisle School Committee will be seated and the chair and vice-chair will be elected. Appointments of the School Committee Recording Secretary, Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer for the Region and the appointment of school committee members for the EDCO Board of Directors, the Adult and Community Education liaison, the CASE Collaborative, and Suburban Coalition will be voted at that time. These appointments require a vote since individuals will be serving as voting members of these committees/boards. All other appointments are made outside of the school committee meeting and do not require a vote.

After a "Call to Order" of the Committee is made, I will request that a Concord School Committee member move the motion to seat the Concord School Committee members by name. Following this, a request will be made for nominations for Chair of the Concord School Committee. Once the election of the Concord School Committee Chair is conducted, that individual or a designee will ask for nominations for Vice Chair.
